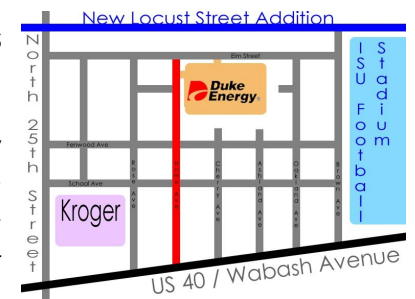


Membership
